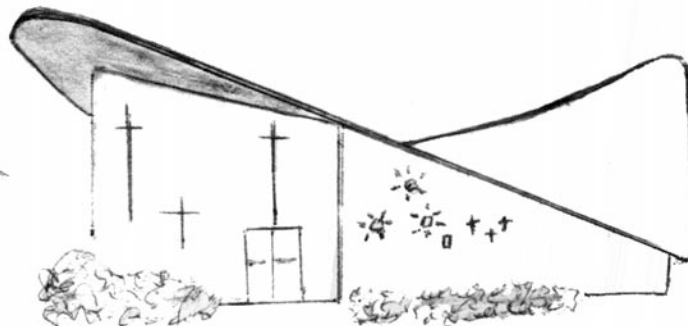

Pastor's Page

The 16th chapter of 1 Samuel tells how David, when he was a boy, was chosen to become the king of Israel. Samuel, God's prophet, was instructed by God to go to Bethlehem and anoint a new king. He was told to seek out a man named Jesse and to choose one of his sons as the next king. The only instruction the Lord gave Samuel was, "Don't judge him by his appearance, for I have rejected him." The Lord doesn't see things the way we do. People judge others by outward appearances; however, the Lord looks at one's heart."

Jesse's seven older sons were mature and strong, but God rejected each one. Samuel asked Jesse if he had any other sons and Jesse reluctantly admitted, "There is David, the youngest, but he is out in the fields watching the sheep and goats."

Do you remember how David got close to King Saul? The king was tormented by a troubling spirit that filled him with depression and fear. His servants suggested that he send for David, the shepherd boy, because David could play the harp. David became close friends with King Saul's son Jonathan. Thus, it was David's musical talent that paved the way for him to become king.

Could we have an anointed king or queen, in the making, among us? I believe that many of our children have been chosen by God to minister to the world.

Camp! Camp! Camp! Camp!

9:00am – 3:00 pm

The Joyful Noise Summer Camp, a six week community outreach program, was designed to richly bless all the children who attend. It begins Monday, June 19th and will run through Friday, July 28th. Please join us Friday, July 7th at 7:00 pm, and again on Friday, July 28th at 7:00 pm when we will celebrate the children and recognize their gifts and accomplishments. We hope to have 60 children attend camp; 20 youth will serve as staff; and at least 20 adults will volunteer as tutors and adult staff. Please help in any way you can. The camp needs the following:

- **Saturday, June 3rd** — Beginning at 8:00am, we will remove the remnants of the school buildings from our grounds so that we can rent two portable buildings for the additional enrollment. The playgrounds and the buildings need to be made ready for the children. We need your time and muscle.
- **Camp staff training** — Tuesday, June 6th and June 13th at 6:00pm., the camp's staff will meet for training. The training retreat will take place Saturday and Sunday, June 10th and 11th.
- **Adult tutors** — We need tutors to spend several hours each week working one-on-one with a child from the camp. Can you help? Materials will be provided. You can choose the age of the child you would like to be paired with. Last summer, the children's favorite thing about camp was the tutoring they received. Share your love, faith, and encouragement with a child, and receive the priceless blessing that results from bonding with a child. Be part of the joy!
- **Scholarships** — It costs \$240 for a child to attend a three week session of summer camp. Please donate to this worthy cause and send a child to camp. All donations are greatly appreciated.
- **Adult volunteers** — We need adults to help with snacks for the children and to help clean up after lunch.

Invite a Child to Attend the Joyful Noise Summer Camp

We have reprinted the camp registration form. Please encourage a child to attend camp by sharing the following:

- The following rotations are offered every week at camp: music and art appreciation, drama, chimes, Spanish, arts and crafts, tutoring, music therapy, and academic enrichment.
- Camp hours are from 9:00am to 3:00pm. Beginning at 6:30 am until 5:30 pm, our youth staff will provide childcare for parents who work for an additional cost.

- There is a sibling discount. Parents pay full price (\$240 for each three week session) for the first child in their family to attend camp; they pay half price (\$120 for each three week session) for each additional child in the family to attend.

• Private music lessons are offered for an additional cost (clarinet, trumpet, trombone, saxophone, flute, piano, guitar, drums) as well as voice lessons.

- We have a new curriculum that is awesome! It contains all types of original music (classical, country, rap, rock and roll, etc.) Lyrics for the music come from the scriptures as do the lessons which are illustrated with original art work.
- We have purchased a 10 foot inflatable water slide for splash day every week.
- Camp is for K through 6th graders.

This camp, in many ways, defines our church's ministry. It is no coincidence that over 40 children now come to Sunday school. Our children are becoming accomplished musicians who perform at church services. We are all blessed by their gifts.

Please pray that this year's Joyful Noise Summer Camp is a huge success.
